

## MATERIALS

### Included

- Shark Template
- Clothes pin

### You Provide

- Glue stick
- Tape
- Scissors
- Glue gun \*if you don't have a glue gun, sticky tacks works well, but won't last as long.



## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut out Big Shark and the little fish from the printed template.
2. Turn the cut outs over and place the top and bottom half together.
3. Line up the top part of Big Shark, and the bottom of the Big Shark. Glue into place with a glue stick – you can add tape for extra security.
4. Line up the two halves and place the clothes pin at the tail end of the with the spring end lined up to the end both sticks – one part of the clothes pin is glued to the top half of the Big Shark and the other to the bottom of the Big Shark. Glue them into place using a glue gun – this will help secure the uneven surface of the clothes pin.
5. Squeeze the clothes pin to open Big Shark's mouth, and line up the Little Fish where you would like it to be seen in the open mouth and glue.
6. Have fun open and closing Baby Shark's mouth, and revealing the little fish!
