Sarah Patterson	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Meeting was started at 11:02am</li> <li>Old Business included discussion of goals met from 2018-2020 report – all completed and results of the Drug and Alcohol Climate Survey completed in April of 2022.</li> <li>Goals completed were more posters around different areas of campus and it was decided to find new ones for the next couple of years if they are in bad shape, the survey, and decrease the number of repeat offenders.</li> <li>Sarah Patterson went through the results of the survey. The committee was impressed by the number of participants (115), the diversity of the participants, that the students who took it knew we have a drug and alcohol policy and believed NMJC was concerned about prevention, and that students felt safe on campus.</li> <li>Sarah Patterson stated she would prepare the next report and send out the yearly notification.</li> <li>The committee felt that our prevention efforts were working, but felt that COVID 19 did have an impact on our decrease in violations.</li> <li>The committee discussed new goals for the 2022 – 2024 report. It was decided to keep doing the survey and try to increase participation, add resources and links to the human resources page and the Drug and Alcohol Prevention webpage for employees as well as have in-person resources at an employee fair, and increase drug and alcohol events on campus for students and employees.
